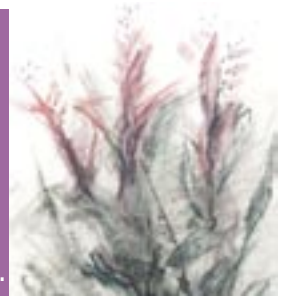

COMPREHENSIVE CARE CENTER SERVICES

Medical Care

Attending physicians provide and coordinate clinic-based medical care with nurses and other specialized health care providers.

- Acute management of HIV disease

Dental Care

- Oral hygiene education
